STREET MARKET SATURDAY 17th JULY

You are invited to apply for a stall in the Street Market to be held on Saturday 17th July 2010 as part of this year's Pilton Festival. Pitches are available in Pilton Street (and separately, for certain types of stall, in Rotary Gardens – see below). The theme, as normal, is the medieval period and is centered on the ancient Green Man and Prior ritual. As before, we wish to emphasise the medieval theme and would appreciate it if you would dress up and decorate your stall accordingly. We would also like to encourage home made, hand made, recycled and "Green" produce.

We would especially like Sellers of handmade items, home made/grown and organic produce, charity stalls, craft stalls, games and competitions, peddlers and buskers, etc.

All stall costs are payable in advance (cheques are payable to Pilton Festival). Please enclose payment and suitable evidence of insurance with the reply slip below.

Additional notes to stall holders:

- *Pilton Street is residential and stalls, backdrops and shelves must not obstruct doorways or windows.*
- *All stalls must provide evidence of suitable public liability insurance. Charity stalls should check they are insured with their chosen charity. Pilton Festival will accept no liability for loss or damage or any claim arising from the actions or produce of the smallholder.*
- *No tables will be available to stall holders. Please bring your own.*
- *All rubbish must be removed.*
- *All stalls will be a maximum of 10 feet wide by 8 feet deep.*
- *Pilton Street will be closed to traffic from 10.00 am to 5.00 pm. and the pavement will be available for stalls. All cars must be removed from the street by 9.45 am. There is plenty of parking locally.*
- *During setup (before 9.45am) and breakdown (from 5pm until 6pm) we will operate a one-way system for vehicles with entry from the bottom of the street, exiting at the top. In the interest of safety, please respect this arrangement.*
