GREEN MAN DAY BEGINS...

Up with the lark are the committee and their helpers to set up Pilton Street, Rotary Gardens and the stages. Bins to put out, marquees to erect and participants to be directed to their positions for the day.

THE PROCESSION

The Procession starts at 11.00am on The Square in Barnstaple. Accompanied by the fabulous Samba Baia, we make our way through the town centre entering Pilton at the bottom of the street. We process up Pilton Street and turn right into Rotary Gardens ready for the first performance of The Pageant at 12.00noon. All are welcome to come and join in - look for the large Green and Red masks leading the way!

THE PAGEANT

(12.00 noon & 3.00 pm in Rotary Gardens)
The Green Man is an ancient Pagan symbol of nature and fertility frequently depicted in carvings in old churches as a face sprouting foliage. A splendid green man carving can be seen in St Mary the Virgin Church in Pilton.

The Prior of the Benedictine Priory of Pilton lived in Bull House below the church until the Reformation. The ritual enacted on Green Man Day is believed to represent the initial antagonism of the two characters, The Prior and The Green Man, represented by red and green masks and the subsequent inclusion of the pagan figure within the church. It takes place in the arena at the top of Rotary Gardens.

Pilton & Green Man Day



Pilton is a self-contained community within Barnstaple which enjoys a unique village atmosphere. The Festival is in the tradition of the legendary charter granted by Edward III in 1344 for a market and fair in Pilton and today it continues to provide a great spectacle of fun, festivities and feasting for people of all ages. It also serves as a valuable platform for local charities to raise awareness and funds. The Festival is non-profit making and we are eternally grateful to the generosity of everyone who has sponsored and supported the committee's fundraising. 




